Guidelines:

- Do not harass any homeowner or resident who are participating in the TNR program by providing food and water to returned cats.
- Do not call Animal Control as they will not remove feral cats.
- Become familiar with Arizona's Cruelty to Animals statute (ARS 13-2910).
- Please properly dispose of any animal waste that may be left on your property.

Deterrents:

- Ultrasound pest control devices and other humane deterrents are permitted to be used on your property, as long as they do not impose a nuisance to neighbors or their pets.
